Presentation Updates – available 2018

- New presentation will still have many of the same components as previous version
 - 2 presenters
 - Companion video
 - Discussion and Q&A with audience
 - Handout
 - Evaluation
- Updated presentation structure
 - IOOV has changed from 6 sections to 4 sections (the new sections are: Introduction, What Happened, What Helps, What's Next)
 - New structure allows for a 40-min, 60-min or 90-min presentation
- New companion video with 2 different options
 - Full length video: 15 minutes (for 60-min and 90-min presentation)
 - Short version video: 8 minutes (for 40-min presentation)
 - DVD and also digital file available
 - Presenters sharing their stories to each other rather than to the screen (modeling empathy)
- Updated audience handout
 - 1-page (back and front) handout that's downloadable from the extranet
 - Includes basic information on mental health and where to learn more or get involved
- Updated evaluation
 - Written evaluation is now 1-page (back and front)
 - We will pilot an online evaluation that can be completed through your cell phone, for appropriate presentation venues – then we'll roll it out to all states

 - Workplace video-facilitated activity
 - Targeted handouts to address workplace mental health
 - Marketing brochure
- We are migrating the data system to a new platform

 - More information will be available as we finalize the updated platform

Training Updates – available 2018

- Presenter training has moved from a 2-day to 1-day in-person training

- Now includes an online portion to draft presentation script before coming to the in-person portion
- New training includes a lot of group work
- Trainees are able to give each other feedback on their presentation that is limited to specific criteria
- Optional PowerPoints available to include in the training

Program Coordination Updates – available 2018

- Coordinators will be able to recommend presenter trainees in the IOOV portal
 - You will be expected to screen trainees, like you do now, before you recommend them to start the online training
 - You only need a trainee’s first name, last name and email address to give them access to the online training
 - Once they are recommended, they will automatically be sent an email to set a password and start the course
 - All of your current presenters will need to complete the online portion as well before using the new presentation materials
- Coordinators will be able to track progress of trainees (and current presenters) as they work on their online trainings and will get notified when they’re done and ready for the in-person training
 - We will be using this system for all future online portions of all program leader trainings

If you are a IOOV presenter, trainer or coordinator

- Be sure you have a nami.org account
- Be sure you are designated as a program leader or coordinator in NAMI 360
- Look out for emails closer to the end of the year for more specifics

If you are a presenter

- You will need to complete the online portion of the training (we will send out directions and info in emails)
- You will get the presentation materials (handout, evaluation, digital video file) from the IOOV extranet and the DVD will be available through the NAMI Store: www.nami.org/store

If you are a trainer

- You will have to complete the same online modules as the presenters
- You will also have to attend or watch an orientation to the new training materials webinar
- We will have “office hour” calls where you can ask questions about the new materials

If you are a coordinator

- Be sure that all of your current presenters are designated so they receive update information
- We will create resources to show you how to recommend, track and update presenters in the system
- The system will send automatic emails to presenter trainees and to you to alert you of status changes
